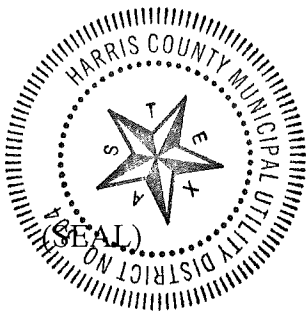
The meeting will be held on *Thursday, October 17, 2019, at 6:00 p.m.*

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:


1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the Board of Directors special meeting of September 24, 2019;
3. Developer Report by DS Silverglen North, LLC;
4. Engagement of McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot PLLC for preparation of developer reimbursement audit relative to Silverglen North, Section 15 water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities;
5. Review and approval of developer reimbursement audit for water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities serving Silverglen North, Section 15, and authorize reimbursement to DS Silverglen North, LLC pursuant to same;
6. Presentation from Acclaim Energy Advisors regarding electricity contract options, consideration of a Resolution Authorizing Entering into Contract for Pooled Purchase of Energy and Authorizing Execution of Related Documents;
7. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's proposed 2019 tax rate;
8. Levy of the District's 2019 debt service and maintenance taxes, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
9. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the Seventh Amended and Restated District Information Form regarding the 2019 tax rate;

 - F. Discussion regarding general engineering matters;

19. Consider approval of Interim Water Supply Agreement with Rankin Road West Municipal Utility District, and status report on feasibility study being prepared in connection with same;
20. Requests for utility commitment and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295, including:
 - A. Preparation of tax exempt tap fee for Fallbrook Baptist Church Education Building; and
 - B. Request for capacity and reimbursement agreement from Echostak Solutions;
21. Status of Active Water Solutions' Modular Sewage Treatment Unit Pilot Testing at the wastewater treatment plant;
22. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - A. Monthly report;
 - B. Repair and maintenance of District facilities, approve proposals and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295, including:
 - i. Repair of Waste Water Treatment Plant clarifier drive;

 - F. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
